Scott is a technology entrepreneur and investor. He began his career by developing an education technology & training program for the global franchises of a leading early childhood education company. Now, Scott is a business advisor, board member, and expert in helping companies enter channel focused technology ecosystems.Scott is an advocate of the 1,1,1 philanthropic model pioneered by Salesforce. He supports many causes, specifically related to anti-human trafficking, and impact measurement.
